### Financial Report:

The cost per skater will be around \$3,000 which does not include travel, food, hotel and their coach costs. Plus, entry fee is \$500 per team. Amanda motioned to give Mr. Peterson the \$700 to help offset the pair teams' expenses going to Colorado camp. Dana stated that all the pair teams going to the camp have contributed their volunteering hours for the club and motioned we disperse \$500 to each of the club members to go to the pair's camp, all were in agreement.

Skate for Hope:

This fundraiser will be taking place on June 17<sup>th</sup> in which 17 skaters will be participating from our rink. Whenever the skaters practiced at our rink Kelly and the skaters have paid out of their pocket. Nate motioned that the club donate \$250 towards the practice ice for the Skate for Hope group, all were in agreement.
